


We can provide 'Wee Breakfasts' and self-cater, pre-prepared evening meals.

Please order breakfasts on arrival or at the time of booking. Please speak to a member of the Team if you require an earlier breakfast.

Self-catering

The kitchen has space for 3 people working at the same time. There are 2 induction hobs with 8 cooking rings, 2 domestic ovens, 1 fridge (no freezer) and 1 microwave.

There is a selection of pots to cater for individuals and groups and crockery and cutlery available to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

Shop

A small shop in reception sells soft drinks, snacks, some grocery and toiletry items, as well as souvenirs and postcards.

Security

All rooms have locks.

Directions

Achmelvich Beach Youth Hostel is 4 miles northwest of Lochinver. Take the B869 for 2 miles and then left for 1 mile. Drive right round to the beach car park.

Parking

Paid parking is available at the nearby Beach Car Park.

Please note, the road is unsuitable for coaches, which should be parked in Lochinver. There is no bike store.

Local activities

Stunning Achmelvich Beach is close by.

Lochinver is just a few miles away, with an excellent visitor centre and local arts & crafts including the Highland Stoneware Pottery.

The hostel is an ideal base for climbing some of the northern mountains.

The hostel offers a Wee Breakfast (normally served from 07.30-09.00) and packed lunches are available. Please reserve at time of booking or at check-in.

Dinner is available when pre-booked for groups of 20+ (minimum 4 weeks' notice).

Self-catering

There are 3 hobs with 12 cooking rings (electric), 3 upright ovens with grills, 3 fridges, 2 microwaves and a toaster.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

The dining area can seat 50 people.

Facilities

A lounge area with TV can seat 50 people and there's additional seating in the reception area.

There are 2 coin-operated washing/ drying machines and free use of a drying room.

Luggage storage is available for guests, please arrange this directly with the hostel.

There's free Wi-Fi access throughout the hostel.

Security

There are keys for all doors and lockers are available in the porch and dormitories.

Outside reception hours the main doors are locked and access to the youth hostel can only be gained by entering a passcode into the door lock system (available from reception on check-in).

Shopping

There are shops and restaurants within easy walking distance.

Confectionary and snacks are available from reception. We also sell a limited stock of alcoholic drinks and a small range of maps and outdoor gear.

Directions

Bus: the bus station is 400m north of the youth hostel.

Train: the train station 400m north of the youth hostel.

Car or on foot: from the south, the youth hostel is 100m on the left after the roundabout. From the north, continue through the village; the youth hostel is 200m on the right past the petrol station.

Parking

Adjoining the youth hostel there's a large car park with coach and car access.

There is secure storage for approximately 20 bicycles.

Local activities

Aviemore is a great year-round location, particularly for outdoor enthusiasts. It's ideally located for walking in Cairngorms National Park. Sports include a variety of snow sports, water sports at nearby Loch Morlich or mountain biking on many nearby trails.

Directions

Car: Braemar Youth Hostel is on the A93 at the southern end of the village and is set back from the road. It's the first building on the right as you enter the village from the south or the last building on the left as you head out towards the Glenshee ski area.

Parking

The car park will hold 15 cars or 1 coach and 5 cars.

There's storage for 20 bicycles with power supply for e-bike charging.

Local activities

Outdoor activities on-site or nearby include cycling, walking, Munros, skiing, snowboarding, pony trekking, golf, Land Rover safaris, swimming, winter climbing, rock climbing, canoeing, orienteering, gorge walking and archery.

Non-sporting attractions include Balmoral Castle (April-July), Castle Trail, Whisky Trail, the Victorian Heritage Trail and the community-run Braemar Castle.

Local festivals/events include Braemar Highland Gathering (first Saturday in September), Braemar Junior Highland Games, Heart of the Park Challenge, Balmoral Tartan 10K race and the Ghillies' Ball.

Catering

Wee Breakfasts are served from 08.00-10.00. For breakfast outside this time please contact the youth hostel directly. Pre-booked packed lunches are also available for groups – minimum order of 20, please order these at time of booking or at least 2 weeks prior.

We are licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages and offer a range of local beer, cider and wine.

Self-catering

The kitchen has space for 10 people working at the same time.

There are 5 gas hobs, 2 ovens, 2 fridges and 1 microwave

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery for all guests.

The dining room can seat up to 30 people at any one time.

Kitchen is closed for an hour during the day for cleaning.

Facilities

The comfortable sitting room (no TV) with views over the bay can accommodate around 25 - 30 people. There's a token-operated washer/dryer located within a drying room area. WiFi access is free.

Security

All rooms have locks.

Some lockers are available in the entrance area - please bring your own padlock.

Cycle storage for up to 15 bikes is available in a lockable wooden shed at the back of the youth hostel.

Shopping

A range of basic food supplies, such as chocolate, canned food, pasta, sauce and soft drinks is available at reception.

There are several restaurants within walking distance.

The village supermarket (5-10 minutes' walk) is open every day. Nearby, fuel is available 24/7.

Directions

Car: Approaching Broadford from the south (from Skye Bridge, Armadale or Kylerhea) take first right turn immediately after crossing Broadford River. The youth hostel is 500m along this minor road.

Parking

The car park (public roadside parking) will hold around 18 cars or 5 cars and a single coach. Further parking space is available in the village.

Cycle storage for up to 15 bikes is available in a lockable shed at the back of the youth hostel.

Local activities

Various walks, from gentle strolls to challenging mountain trails, are close by or within a short driving distance. Horse riding is available on the island and the Isle of Skye golf club is about 20 minutes' drive away. Skye offers ideal sea kayaking opportunities and courses for all levels can be taken within close driving distance.

Guests can also take advantage of a 15% discount with ACE Target Sports near Portree and a 10% discount on Bella Jane boat trips from Elgol.

Non-sporting attractions include boat trips from Elgol (about 30 minutes' drive) towards Loch Coruisk, music festivals, sheepdog trials and other cultural events throughout summer in various locations on the island. The Skye Highland Games take place in Portree in August.

None of the rooms are en-suite, but some have wash basins.

There are 12 individual washrooms

(7 upstairs and 5 downstairs) 4 male and 4 female toilets; 2 unisex toilets and 1 disabled shower/toilet.

Room configurations may be subject to occasional change.

Catering

A full catering service is available for both individuals and groups.

We can provide wee breakfasts or full cooked breakfasts, packed lunches and a choice of 1, 2 or 3 course evening meals which are freshly prepared on the premises.

Breakfast is usually served from 07.30-09.00 and evening meals at an agreed time between 17.00-20.00 with last orders at 19.45.

We are licensed for residents, selling red and white wine, cider and locally brewed Cairngorm beer.

The dining room can seat 60 people. Groups of 10 or more should reserve any catering requirements at the time of booking to avoid disappointment. Small parties, couples and individuals can order on arrival at the hostel.

Self-catering

The kitchen is open from 07.00 to 22.30 and has space for 6 people.

There are 3 hobs, 3 oven, 1 microwave and 2 fridges.

A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

Facilities

Although there's no TV reception, the lounge area has a large selection of movies and a pool table.

There are 2 coin-operated washing machines/dryers and free access to a medium-sized drying room.

Wi-Fi access is free and available throughout the hostel.

Security

All rooms have locks.

Padlock lockers are available in the locker room and padlocks may be purchased at reception (or bring your own).

Shopping

Basic personal supplies can be purchased at reception.

Directions

Car: take the B970 from the south end of Aviemore for 7 miles in the direction of Coylumbridge, Cairngorm, Loch Morlich Watersports. The hostel turn is opposite Glenmore Shop.

Parking

There are 17 car parking spaces but coach parking is subject to availability.

The bike shed will hold a maximum of 8 cycles.

Local activities

Outdoor activities near the youth hostel include hillwalking, mountain-biking, skiing and snowboarding, watersports, the Cairngorm Reindeer Herd and visits to castles.

At the halfway point on the West Highland Way, the hostel provides a welcome rest for tired feet, to re-fuel, dry your kit and equipment, and get a good night's sleep.

For Munro Baggers, Crianlarich's Central Scotland location is the ideal base to reach many of the Hugh Munro 3000ft mountains; we believe there are in the region of 70 Munros within 45 minutes' drive taking in the Southern Highland, and South West Highlands Munro regions.

Our Hostel facilities are ideal for the walking, rambling, university, and mountaineering groups.

All rooms have washbasins, all bed linen is provided, private rooms have towels inclusive of the price, and towels are also available to hire.

Self-catering

The kitchen is open between 07.00-10.00 and 15.00-23.00 and has space for 4 people.

There are 2 electric hobs, 2 ovens,

2 fridges and 1 microwave, toasters, and constant boiling water. A selection of pots is available to cater for individuals and groups and there's sufficient crockery and cutlery to suit staggered meal times for all guests.

The dining room can seat 44 people.

We're fully licensed, selling a selection of beer, wine and cider.

Facilities

The small lounge (with TV) can seat 13. There's a token-operated washer/dryer and a medium-sized drying room (free). Wi-Fi access is free.

Security

All rooms have key card locks and every shared room bed has its own individual locker. Please bring your own padlock or purchase one at reception.

Shopping

We sell meals you can cook yourself in our self-catering kitchen, along with a selection of crisps and confectionary, alcoholic and soft drinks.

Directions

A82 from Glasgow-Crianlarich: at the roundabout take the second junction on the left, heading for Crianlarich Village. Turn right at T-junction A85, then first right past the village shop and continue up Station Road.

The youth hostel is 150m on the left after the local shop. If you miss the A82 south roundabout, you can access the village from the west - just follow the signs for Crianlarich Village, go under the railway bridge, pass the T-junction, go under the railway viaduct and take the first right junction - we are up the road on the left.

From A85 from Stirling-Crianlarich:

take the first junction on the left after the police station. Continue up Station Road and the youth hostel is 150m on the left after the local shop.

Parking

The car park in front of the hostel will hold around 23 cars, or 2 coaches and fewer cars.

There's secure cycle storage for up to 16 bikes (30m from main building).

Local Activities

Crianlarich Youth Hostel has in the region of 70 Munros within 45 minutes' drive and it's also a key location for walkers at the half-way point for undertaking the West Highland Way.

Crianlarich Community Woodland Walk and Cruach Ardrain Munro start from the youth hostel and can be accessed via forestry service roads.

Ben More and Stob Binnien are 3 miles to the east and also within walking distance from the hostel.

For other Munros locally, we suggest bicycles, car, or public transport via excellent rail and bus links to access them.

There are regular visits from steam trains in the summer travelling to Mallaig via the famous Glenfinnan Viaduct from Harry Potter fame. Crianlarich train station is 5 minutes' walk from the hostel.

St Fillan's Priory; the healing pools, and Dalrigh Battlefield where Robert the Bruce fought the Clan MacDougall in 1306 are 4 miles away.

Other activities nearby, or within an hour's drive, include fishing for brown trout and salmon on the River Fillan, Loch Dochart and River Dochart; permits can be bought here at the hostel from £8.00 per day.

There are 9-hole golf courses at Killin (11 miles) and Dalmally (16 miles) and gold panning in Tyndrum (5 miles).

The Rob Roy Way is a short distance from the hostel making us an ideal overnight stay for cyclists and walkers completing this iconic challenge; we have secure bike storage.

The nearest Tourist Information Centre is in Tyndrum but please ask the staff any questions to see if they can help.

Accessibility

Crianlarich Youth Hostel is suitable for people with impaired mobility:

- Disabled access is good, with ramped access to the front entrance of the Hostel and the front door can extend when required.

In the winter, the N41 (no Sunday service) runs to the hostel only twice a day, leaving Fort William Middle Street in the early morning and late afternoon. The N41 also leaves the hostel for Fort William at 09.11 Monday – Saturday.

Parking

The car park will hold around 15 cars. Official coach parking is available in the

West End Car Park, Fort William. If space permits, roadside parking may be available.

There's secure cycle storage for up to 12 bicycles at the rear of the building.

Local activities

The climb to Ben Nevis, the highest mountain in Scotland (and the UK) is directly opposite the entrance to the youth hostel. The West Highland Way also ends here. It's a great base for winter sports as well as summer.





Train: take the train to Kyle, then catch the bus, from the bus stop it's about a 2 mile walk to the hostel.

Car: from Inverness or Fort William take the road to the Isle of Skye. Turn off A87 at Shiel Bridge (signposted Ratagan). After 0.75 mile turn right down to the hostel.

Foot: from Shiel Bridge, walk 2 miles, following the signs for Ratagan. Walk through the village on the loch-side to the hostel.

Parking

The car park will hold around 14 cars or 9 cars and 1 coach.

There's secure cycle storage for up to 8 bikes.

Local activities

There are seals, otters, badgers and pine martens in the area. Red deer are numerous and on the mountains you can see ravens, ptarmigan, sea eagles, golden eagles and mountain hares.

Ratagan Youth Hostel is only 8 miles from world-famous Eilean Donan Castle. The Five Sisters of Kintail are within easy reach, along with an almost endless choice of alternative walks


